It is with great excitement and experience that I apply for the position of Content - Production Editor. I believe I have the professional experience and love for Jesus required to create, edit, and to support the sharing of engaging and grammatically correct Biblical content. I truly believe God has called me to use my gifts in visual storytelling, writing, and creative design to help others spread their valuable messages.

For the past eight years, I have been working as an independent content creator and consultant for local and international non profit organizations. I regularly write compelling story narratives, summarize information for social media captions, and draft engaging website content for use by requesting non profits. Additionally, I am often hired to personally film at events (or to coalesce previously acquired footage) in order to create meaningful marketing videos.

Several examples of recent visual and written content that I have produced, created, and edited are below:

- **US Humane Society and additional partners:** Lead content creator, scriptwriter, director, and speaker in weekly updates for the Nation's largest 4,000 Envigo beagle rescue mission.
- Priceless Pets: Collaborate with website design companies to draft, edit, and publish written and visual content.
 - For example, a majority of the verbiage and all videos published on the <u>Chino Hills</u>, <u>Claremont</u>, and <u>Costa Mesa</u> location pages were produced by myself.
 - Document and create content showcasing <u>staff interviews</u> and <u>animal rescue missions</u>; including the emergency rescue of over <u>300 shelter animals</u> from euthanasia in Texas.
- **UAnimals:** Produced, planned, and lead a social media and fitness <u>fundraising campaign</u> that spanned three different counties in Southern California.
 - To successfully do so, I planned and accomplished the following:
 - The creation of social media infographic packages for different businesses and partners to readily share.
 - The management of the RSVP list of donors and attendees at fundraising events.
 - The editing of key interview takeaways into shareable video content.
 - Openly discussed details of the campaign while being filmed for a local TV news segment.

In addition to working as a content creator and producer, I am also an <u>assistant professor</u> at a Christian university. I am blessed to be able to create and organize instructional curriculum from a faith-based foundation. As a professor, I hold myself to high academic standards; consistently checking for grammatically correct assignments, professionally working with other faculty, and bringing my own unique energy to the classroom. In the past, I have also managed the editing and posting of <u>blogs</u> to FirstCarbon Solution's website. Prior to 2020, I volunteered with Inland Hills Church production team as their lead announcement speaker for online and in-person Church services.

Personally, I do believe that I am well-equipped to join the Lifeway team as the Content - Production Editor. I find joy and purpose in helping others to share their own; especially with a focus on spreading Biblical truths and the love of Jesus. Each morning, I spend time reading my Bible and writing my own journal reflections on scripture. I regularly share these written messages with others via social media and occasionally through recorded YouTube <u>videos</u>. I do believe that God is calling me into a professional role where I can share my current strengths while also learning new skills. It is my hope that Lifeway is the next step in his journey for me.
